



Approval by legal guardians regarding passport issuance for an individual under 18 years of age

V-904

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When a passport application is made for a child younger than 18 years, both legal guardians, if applicable, shall present themselves, together with the child, to apply for the child's passport. If one of the child's legal guardians cannot be present, he/she shall sign his/her attested approval on this form. If a child's legal guardians are other than the parents, the same provisions apply to their approval. If those who sign this approval do not have Icelandic ID numbers, a copy of their ID cards must follow.

Child's custody arrangements can be obtained on my pages on www.island.is. Before the passport is issued, Registers Iceland will verify the child's custody.

It can be punishable by law to provide false information on custody according to Article 10 of Act No 136/1998 on passports.
